The Addictions Receiving Facility provides services to the residents of Orange, Osceola, Seminole and Brevard counties. The following is our client profile:

- 50% involuntary clients
- 40% Co-occurring clients
- 45% medically complex clients
- Admitted 2366 during 2008
- 67% male and 33% female
- 66% White 14% Black 20% Hispanic
- 25% Homeless; 50% unemployed

Exclusionary Criteria:

- Unable to do daily ADL's
- Needing IV treatment
- In need of chemical restraint
- Meets Baker Act criteria
- Congestive heart failure/unstable
- Unstable angina
- Client without expensive heart medications
- Unstable diabetic such as glucose over 500
- Overly sedated at admission i.e. diabetic coma
- Violent Behavior

Medical Services Provided: We provide medical detox and provide basic medical care. We have no in house laboratory for immediate lab results; therefore any condition requiring immediate labs is referred out. On a scale of 1-5 we provide medical services at a level 3.

Co-occurring clients receive medications either through our own medications or through our formulary, samples or sometimes purchased. We have a psychiatric ARNP who is also the Nursing Manager. She sees co-occurring clients going to our residential units. The other ARNP's are comfortable prescribing medications for psychiatric conditions when needed. We refer to our local mental health facilities for long term medication needs. On a scale of 1-5 we provide psychiatric services at a level 4.5. Although we have a seclusion room we do not use seclusion and restraint.

We have a clinical manager who is licensed and certified. She supervises 3 counselors who provide groups, psychosocial assessments, referrals and transition plans. They also do court assessments for the Marchman Act. We have no funding for follow-up services.
