This meeting is in follow-up to the pilot-testing of the evidence-based practice (EPB) survey instrument developed by the Department of Children and Families (DCF) Substance Abuse Program Office. Agencies that are located in the Southern region of the state, that volunteered to pilot-test the tool, will be asked to attend this meeting to discuss the results of the tool within their respective programs.

Volunteer provider agencies who have indicated they are willing to use the tool within their agency are asked to:

- 1) Listen to the webinar on the use of the survey instrument held in March 2010;
- 2) Complete the survey tool for the EBPs used within their agency; and, then
- 3) Attend the April 16 meeting to discuss how well the tool worked, identify problems and recommend changes to the tool.

The tool will be modified by DCF Substance Abuse staff based on input and feedback obtained at this meeting. In May, peer mentoring teams will be trained to assist agencies in implementing the tool in other areas across the state.
