Studies have shown that community based anti-drug coalitions are very effective in reducing drug use. Because every community has its own unique drug-related problems, the Florida Counterdrug Training Academy (FCTA), in conjunction with state and national prevention experts, has developed a curriculum designed to assist in the development and sustainment of Community Anti-Drug Coalitions. Participants attending this course will learn to build the foundation of an effective coalition by:

- ⇒ Recognizing the need to mobilize a community's own resources;
- ⇒ Understanding risk and protective factors;
- ⇒ Developing comprehensive strategies for prevention programs;
- ⇒ Becoming familiar with measurement tools;
- ⇒ Accepting the need to evaluate and publicize programs.

The Community Anti-Drug Coalition Building course is conducted monthly at Camp Blanding in Starke, Florida. Training spans the length of three days and is provided free of charge to every community.
